**Admissions Consultation on proposed changes to Lionheart Educational Trust
Brocks Hill Primary School**

**Admission Arrangements for the 2027-2028 school year.
Period of Consultation: Monday 3th November 2025 to Friday 12th December 2025**

As part of Lionheart Educational Trust, from Monday 3rd November until Friday 12th December 2025 Brockshill Primary School will be consulting on proposed changes to their 2027-2028 admission arrangements. All schools/academies/colleges must have admission arrangements that clearly set out how children will be admitted, including information about what happens if there are more applications than places available (oversubscription criteria). The criteria must be reasonable, clear, objective, and procedurally fair and comply with all relevant legislation, including equalities legislation. It is for the admissions authority (Lionheart Educational Trust) to decide which criteria are most suitable for the school/academy according to local circumstances.

The Proposed Changes:

Brocks Hill Primary school are consulting on changing their Published Admission Number (PAN) from 60 to 90. No other material changes have been made to the policy however changes to detail and wording have been made throughout, these do not affect the admission process or the rights of those applying to the school.

Who are we consulting with?

The School Admissions Code 2021 requires that all admission authorities undertake a statutory consultation to seek the views and comments of parents/carers, other admission authorities, schools in the relevant area, Leicester City and County Council including neighbouring local authorities and anyone else who may be affected by the proposed changes.
